Henry County Public Health to offer free COVID-19 test kits

Test lowa has transitioned from hosting drive-through sites to providing take-home test kits and Henry County Public Health will become a pick-up site for the free test kits effective Thursday, July 22nd. These test kits will be saliva sample PCR tests that you can do at home and send directly to the State Hygienic Lab.

To request a test please call our office at 319-385-0779 to make an appointment. Please do not come inside our office if you are sick or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19. The test kit will contain instructions and samples can be returned using a UPS drop-off box (at U.S. Bank, Pilot, and Alaniz in Mt. Pleasant).
